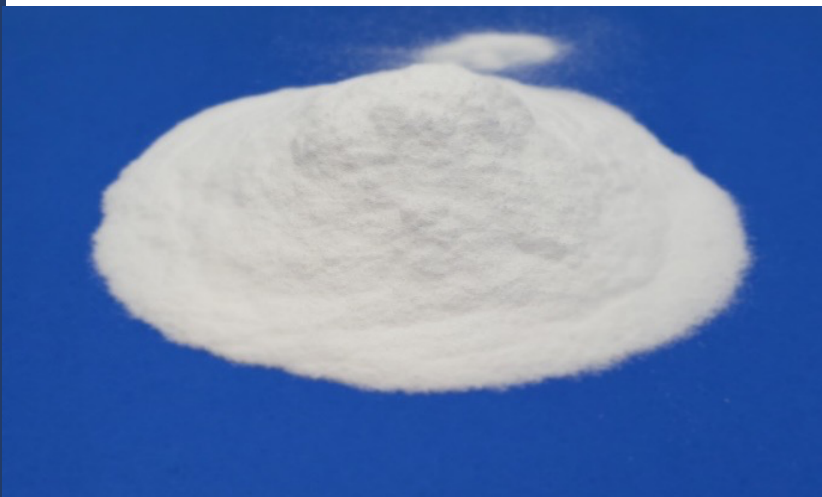




# Dextrose



## Description:

**Dextrose**, the monohydrate form of glucose, is a white crystalline sugar manufactured by enzymatic conversion of corn starch. It is mildly sweet (about 70% as sweet as sucrose), highly fermentable, and a natural flavor enhancer. Dextrose is readily used in dairy & veal calf and lactating cow diets as a carbohydrate energy source, feed intake enhancer, and natural sweetener.
