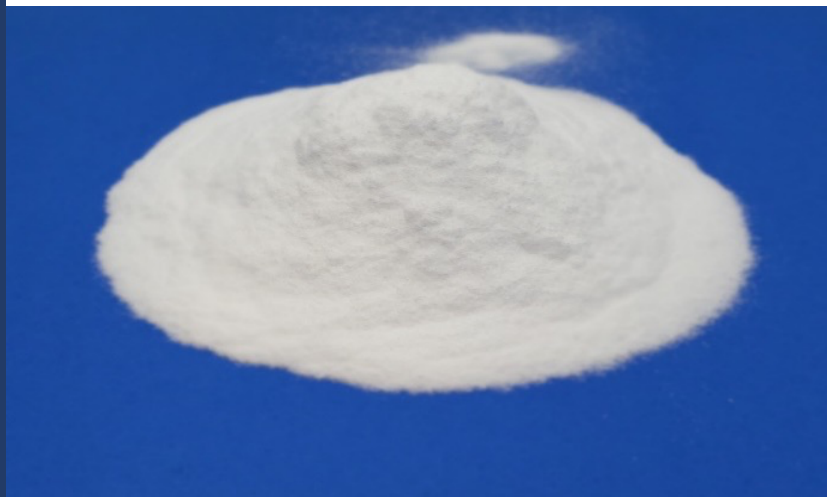




Dextrose



Description:

Dextrose, the monohydrate form of glucose, is a white crystalline sugar manufactured by enzymatic conversion of corn starch. It is mildly sweet (about 70% as sweet as sucrose), highly fermentable, and a natural flavor enhancer. Dextrose is readily used in pig starter and sow lactation diets as a carbohydrate energy source, feed intake enhancer, and natural sweetener. Typical inclusion levels range from 5-20% of the diet.
