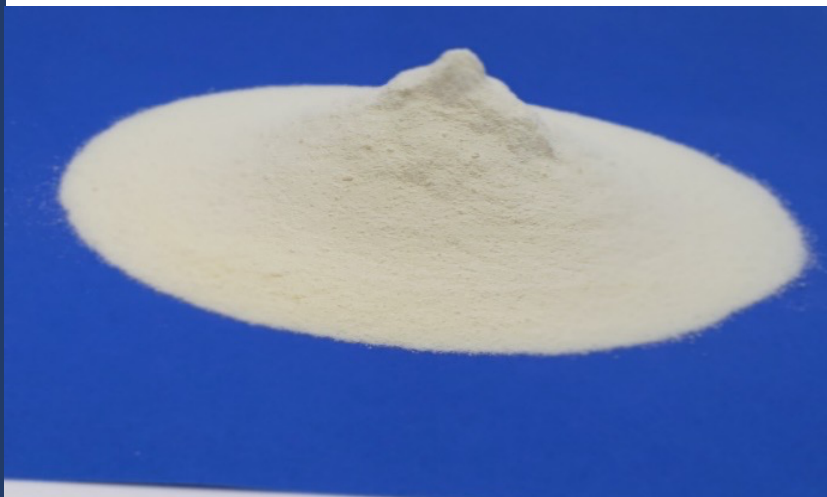




Lactose



Description:

Lactose Monohydrate is milk sugar (disaccharide of glucose and galactose) that is fractionated and crystalized from whey streams in the cheese-making process. Lactose is readily digestible due to high levels of the intestinal enzyme lactase, naturally present in the young pig. Lactose, as a nutrient, is essential for optimal performance and gut health of young pigs.
