Granulated Sugar is a white crystalline sugar that is commonly used in swine pig starter and sow lactation diets to provide readily digestible energy and sweetness. Chemically, it is known as sucrose, a disaccharide of glucose and fructose. There are two common sources—beet sugar and cane sugar—with the same final chemical composition and sweetness.
