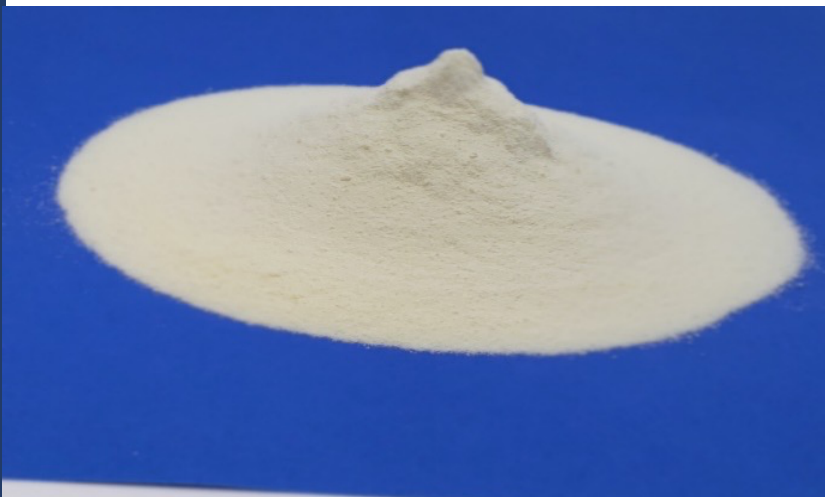




Lactose



Description:

Lactose Monohydrate is milk sugar (disaccharide of glucose and galactose with one molecule of water) that is fractionated and crystallized from whey streams in the cheese-making process. Lactose is readily used in milk replacers and dry starter feeds for dairy and veal calves. Lactose, as a nutrient, is considered to be essential for optimal performance and gut health of calves. Typical inclusion levels range between 5-20% of the diet.
